On June 25, 2024, our Emergency Management Team participated in a full-scale, FEMA-evaluated exercise. This exercise is mandated by the Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) Program to ensure that all involved governmental partners can effectively respond to emergencies related to Xcel Energy's Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant.

The exercise involved two states, three counties, and a total of 425 participants, with 58 from Goodhue County alone. FEMA deployed 35 evaluators across several locations during the exercise, and all demonstrated that appropriate measures were taken in the given scenario. Goodhue County successfully met all ten targets set, showcasing the seamless and flexible nature of our operations.

Achieving this level of performance requires ongoing daily work to improve our preparedness.
