RE: **Out-of-State Travel Request**

We respectfully request approval for out-of-state travel in 2026 for Emergency Services Captain Chad Steffen related to his ongoing participation in the SAFECOM Program.

Captain Steffen has served as an appointed SAFECOM Public Safety At-Large Member since 2018. SAFECOM is a national emergency communications program under the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA). Captain Steffen is one of approximately 25 At-Large Members nationwide and currently serves as Vice-Chair of the Education & Outreach Committee.

Sheriff Kelly is requesting approval for Captain Steffen to continue participating in SAFECOM's bi-annual meetings and one annual committee meeting. Historically, these meetings included in-person attendance and were fully funded by the SAFECOM Program, with the county's only obligation being Captain Steffen's time commitment, which generally does not exceed 75 hours annually.

Since March of 2020, SAFECOM has not met in person, and the likelihood of in-person meetings remains rare for the foreseeable future. This request is therefore precautionary in nature, ensuring authorization is in place should limited in-person meetings resume.

This request has been approved in prior years, and the county continues to benefit from representation in national emergency communications policy, interoperability planning, and best practices that directly support local and regional public safety operations.

**Recommendation:**

We respectfully request the County Board's approval for this out-of-state travel authorization for 2026.
