RE: Appointment to the Planning Advisory Commission

SUMMARY:

Charlie Dicke is being brought forward as a recommended appointment to the Planning Advisory Commission. Mr. Dicke lives in rural Red Wing, and will replace Tom Gale on the Commission.

BACKGROUND:

The Planning Advisory Commission is a seven-member board where each member serves a 3-year term starting January 1st and continuing through December 31st. Members are eligible for re-appointment at the discretion of the County Board. Members can serve up to three consecutive 3-year terms.
