The Grant was initially granted to run from 09/01/2025 until 02/28/2027, however due to timing issues with the state, the Grant timeline has been extended to 06/30/2027. The Grant award of \$494, 713.00 remains the same.

This amendment (“Amendment”) is by and between the State of Minnesota, through its Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Children, Youth, and Families, ~~Office of Economic Opportunity~~**Office of Restorative Practices** (“STATE”) and **Goodhue County, Court Services**, located at 454 W 6th Street, Red Wing, MN 55066, an independent contractor, not an employee of the State of Minnesota (“GRANTEE”).

Recitals

1. STATE has a grant contract with GRANTEE identified as Grant No. 275524 to promote initiatives statewide that are creating new restorative practice programs or have current programs in place. (Original Grant Contract);
2. The Original Grant Contract is being amended because STATE and GRANTEE agree that additional time and duties are necessary for the satisfactory completion of the Original Grant Contract;
3. STATE and GRANTEE agree to amend the Original Grant Contract as stated below:

Contract Amendment

In this Amendment, changes to Original Grant Contract language will use ~~strike through~~ for deletions and underlining for insertions.

The parties agree to the following revisions:

REVISION 1: Clause 1, “**CONTRACT TERMS AND SURVIVAL OF TERMS,**” subclause 1.2., “**Expiration date,**” is amended as follows:

1.2. Expiration date. This CONTRACT is valid through ~~February 27, 2027~~June 30, 2027, or until all obligations set forth in this CONTRACT have been satisfactorily fulfilled, whichever occurs first.

REVISION 2: Clause 2, “**GRANTEE’S DUTIES,**” subclause 2.1., “**Duties,**” is amended as follows:

2.1. Duties. GRANTEE shall perform duties in accordance with **Attachment A-1**, Work Plan, which is attached and incorporated into this CONTRACT.

REVISION 3: Clause 3, “**CONSIDERATION AND TERMS OF PAYMENT**,” subclause 3.1.a, “**Compensation**,” only, is amended as follows:

a. Compensation.

1. GRANTEE will be paid in accordance with **Attachment B-1**, Budget, which is attached and incorporated into this CONTRACT.
2. Budget Modification.
 - a. GRANTEE must obtain STATE written approval before changing any part of the budget.
 - b. Notwithstanding Clause 17.1 of CONTRACT, shifting of funds between budget line items does not require an amendment if the amount shifted does not exceed ~~two hundred dollars (\$200.00)~~ or ten percent (10%) of that budget year total, ~~whichever is lower~~, and does not change the total obligation amount.
 - c. If GRANTEE’s approved budget changes proceed without an amendment pursuant to this clause, GRANTEE must record the budget change in Enterprise Grant Management System (EGMS) or on a form provided by STATE.

REVISION 4:

Attachments A-1 and B-1, attached to this amendment, are hereby attached and incorporated into the Original Grant Contract and replace Attachments A and B.

EXCEPT AS AMENDED HEREIN, THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE ORIGINAL GRANT CONTRACT AND ALL PREVIOUS AMENDMENTS REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AND ARE INCORPORATED INTO THIS AMENDMENT BY REFERENCE.
