

Services we provide to families:



Promote whole-family systems, reduce disparities, and produce equitable outcomes in delivery and receipt of child support services.

- Integrate whole-family approaches throughout the program, including practice, program, and policy decision-making. The approaches recognize and address the needs of children and adults simultaneously.
- Improve demographic data collection to better understand programmatic disparities and create comprehensive equity goals that reduce disparities in marginalized communities.
- Enhance intergovernmental relationships with Tribal partners to ensure children have the support they need.
- Partner with other programs to develop new strategies that support the needs of families like integrating employment services with child support.
- Continue to analyze and modify enforcement practices in ways that are less harmful and benefit the whole family.
- Build on strategies to improve service to vulnerable populations such as those experiencing domestic violence.
- Work with national partners to advocate for federal performance measure changes more aligned with whole-family systems.
