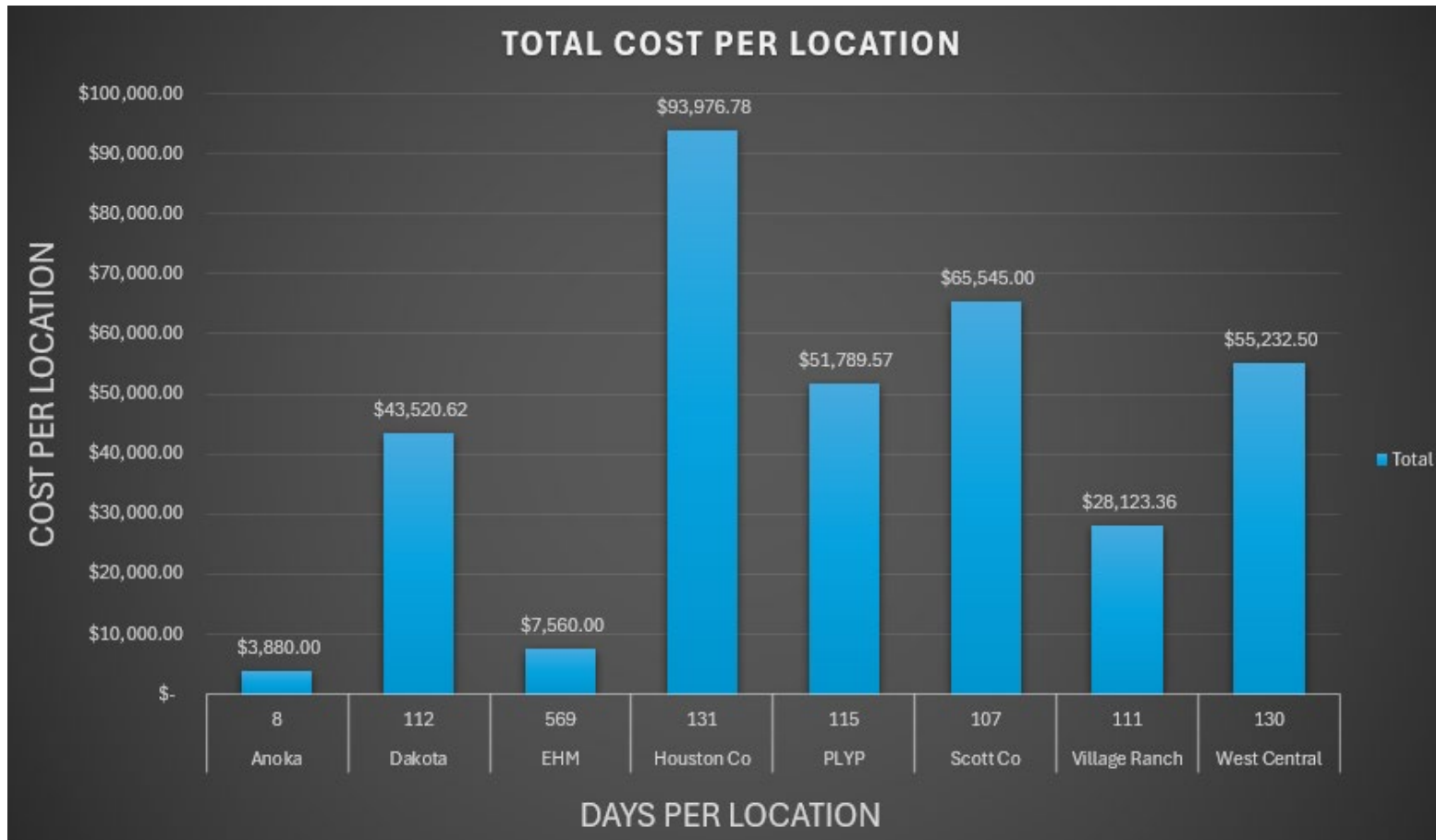
Services

- **Programming & referrals** - Court-ordered programs and connections to needed resources.
- **Individual therapy** - Focused support for emotional and behavioral needs.
- **SUD treatment** - Substance-use assessments and recovery programming.
- **Mental health treatment** - Evaluations, therapy, and psychiatric support when needed.
- **Skills work** - Building coping skills, decision-making, and daily living abilities.
- **In-home family work/therapy** - Support provided in the home to improve family communication and address behaviors.
- **Group homes** - Structured living environments offering supervision, skills work, and therapeutic support.
- **Case management** - Provides broad support by assessing needs, coordinating services, and helping juveniles and families stay connected to essential resources.
- **Children's mental health case management** - Delivers specialized coordination for youth with mental health needs, linking assessments, therapy, school supports, and community resources into a cohesive plan.

Placement Utilization

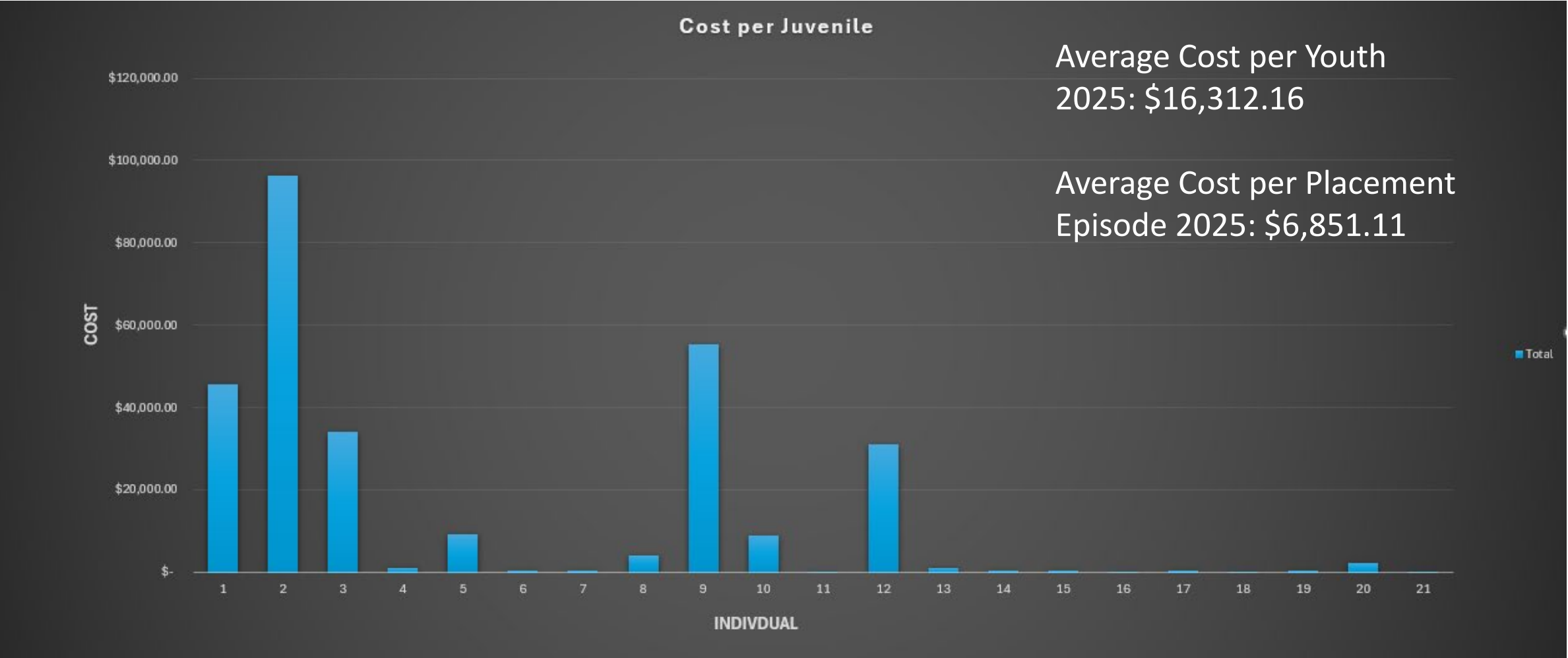
- **Anoka County** - Juvenile Detention Center (67 miles)

Placement Facts

Single vs Multiple Placement

- 12 individuals experienced single placement
- 7 individuals experienced multiple placement
- 1 individual experienced 7 different placement options
- Individuals with multiple placements had multiple years of supervision

Houston County

- Most Costly facility (\$717.38/day)
- Juveniles who have been charged during other placements

Individual Outcomes for 2025

- 10 Successfully discharged from probation
- 9 ongoing cases
- 1 individual transferred to home county
- 1 individual turned 18 and was discharged unsuccessfully from probation

Key Factors Leading to Placement

- **Mental health challenges** are present in nearly all youth and represent the most significant barrier to progress.
- **Substance abuse concerns** are widespread and often closely linked with mental health issues.
- **Limited success in traditional schooling** with only one youth participating in mainstream classes without being provided an Individualized Education Program.
- **Poor school attendance** and inconsistent engagement continue to affect overall outcomes.
- **Ongoing charged offenses** contribute to more involvement in the system.
- **Assaultive behavior** contributed to needing support from services/resources.
