Goodhue County Board of Commissioners May 21, 2024

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Request of Board

 Approval of the awards from application for requesting funds from the Goodhue County Affordable Housing Trust Fund and statewide affordable housing aid funds which utilized the same application

Application

- Goodhue County Board approved February 6, 2024
- Simple
- Focus on broad affordable definition to attract and include all affordable housing options
 - 80% area median income for rental/single family rehab
 - 115% area median income single family new construction
- Applications: local government, nonprofits, landlord or developer that filed taxes in 2022
- Goal was to leverage dollars to build and preserve housing stock

Application

- Application was on SEMMCHRA's website and included broad communication.
 - Press release is included in board packet
 - Goodhue County Communication Team and Branding
- Due to SEMMCHRA by April 1, 2024

Application

- Applications were reviewed and recommended for approval by SEMMCHRA Staff, SEMMCHRA Board, and Goodhue County Housing Trust Fund Committee in April.
- Applications were assessed for impact, readiness, preservation/creation of housing, etc.
- Recommendation for approval to Goodhue County Board today and notification of awards in May.

Awards Recommended for Approval

- The Goodhue County Housing Trust Fund Committee recommends that all applications received be funded.
- All fulfill the ordinance requirements.
- Diversity in
 - Rehabilitation and creation
 - For-profit and nonprofit
 - Location
 - Funding Structure

Application Summary

Habitat for Humanity

- \$40,000 grant to purchase two lots in Kenyon TIF District.
- Partner with Kenyon High School and utilize reliable volunteer labor force to reduce costs.
- Build two single-family homes for families at 30-80% AMI.
- Pursuing further funds from MHFA to gap finance.

Bigelow & Lennon Construction

- \$245,000 loan to build out Kenyon TIF district.
- For-profit entity with experience building affordable homes in SE Minnesota.
- 5-6 new single-family homes for families at 115% AMI.

Application Summary

SEMMCHRA

- \$279,750 15-year, deferred and forgivable loan.
- Complete exterior system rehab: windows, siding, doors, gutters, etc.
- Preserving 12 rental units restricted for families at 80% AMI. Multiple projectbased section 8 units.

Three Rivers CAC

- \$48,000 grant for work on drainage, siding, and furnaces.
- Preserving 18-units rental units restricted for families at 60% AMI.
- Purchased and rehabbed in 2011 to preserve affordability.
- Current debt load limits alternative funding sources.

Application Summary

Cannon Falls Housing Initiative

- \$35,000 grant to purchase a new lot to build a new single-family home.
- Partner with Cannon Falls High School for labor and provide builders education to students.
- Homes are targeted for families living and working in Cannon Falls and under 115% AMI.

Cannon Falls Housing Initiative

- \$73,500 grant to get the home into the First Homes Community Land Trust.
- Funding would cover 25% of the equity of the home needed to enter the land trust and avoid PMI.
- Affordability is preserved for 99 years
