Kenyon Cleanup Day – June 29, 2024

Date: 10 July 2024

Summary

On June 29, 2024, Goodhue County held the first of five cleanup days at the County Maintenance Facility in Kenyon from 8 am to 12 pm. A total of six County employees were at the event to assist customers, collect payment, and assess operations to better staff future events. Four employees from the recycling center, the director, and deputy director of public works were present.

Available items to drop off consisted of five categories: scrap metal, appliances, electronics, tires, and furniture. Pricing was pursuant to the Goodhue County fee structure and materials dropped off were subject to the State of Minnesota's solid waste tax.

Sixteen customers dropped off items for disposal. Thirteen customers were from Kenyon, two were from Cannon Falls, and one was from Wanamingo. A total of 45 items were collected for disposal. The items consisted of:

- Washer/dryer/stove/water heater/microwave = 6
- Dehumidifier = 1
- Refrigerator = 1
- Couches = 2
- Mattresses = 4
- Computers/fax machines/laptops/scanners/receivers/DVDs/VCRs/vacuums = 20
- TVs less than 20" = 7
- TVs greater than 27" = 1
- Other (i.e. sewing machines) = 3
- Scrap metal = 0
- Tires = 0

The next cleanup day is scheduled for July 27, 2024 at the County Maintenance Facility in Kenyon.
