WHEREAS: The duties performed by county, city, Tribal, and state health and human services workers require a variety of skills to provide services to clients, communities, and the general public; and

WHEREAS: The nature of federal and state legislation relies on county, city, Tribal, and state health and human services workers who continually expand their knowledge, skills, and expertise related to their professions and the needs of the communities they serve; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota recognizes the valuable public services that county, city, Tribal, and state health and human services workers perform every day for the health, prevention, and protection of people in Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, December 11, 2024, as:

COUNTY, CITY, TRIBAL, AND STATE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES WORKER DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
