Background

On May 18, 2004, the County Board adopted Official Highway Map #1. A copy of the official map is included. This was a cooperative effort between Goodhue County and Olmsted County, with participation from the City of Pine Island and MnDOT. Adoption of the official map did not constitute acquisition of the property but indicated to landowners property that was intended to be acquired at a future time.


Official Highway Map #1 identified a realignment of CSAH 11 from CR 55 to TH 52, intersecting TH 52 at a proposed new interchange on the north side of Pine Island. The map also identified a new interchange in Olmsted County along with a frontage road network. Construction of the interchange in Olmsted County and frontage roads on the east side of TH 52 was completed by MnDOT as part of the Elk Run Interchange project. Since that time, development has not occurred as anticipated. Furthermore, plans from the City, County, and MnDOT have changed. MnDOT has stated that they currently do not support a second interchange in the City of Pine Island, and they have no future plans for an interchange. The County has a planned project to reconstruct CSAH 11 from CR 55 to the east County line on its existing alignment, which crosses TH 52 at an existing interchange. The current alignment of CSAH 11 serves the County's transportation needs.

On November 21, 2024 the City of Pine Island contacted the County to request that Official Highway Map #1. On January 21, 2025, the City Council passed a resolution in support of repealing the official map. The City has a developer that is proposing a new industrial development on the north side of Pine Island, east of TH 52. The official map encompasses the property that the developer is interested in purchasing. Repealing the official map would remove an encumbrance on property.


Goodhue County is the responsible agency for the map given that the County Board adopted it. The process for the County to repeal the map involves a public hearing at Planning Commission and action by the County Board. Staff is beginning this process because of the request received by the City and the County's plan to maintain CSAH 11 on its existing alignment using the existing interchange.


The request to repeal the official map is scheduled to be presented to the Planning Commission on March 17, 2025. If approved by the Planning Commission, it is anticipated that the request to repeal the official map will be presented to the County Board for action at meeting on April 1, 2025.



RESOLUTION NO. 25-07

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING REPEAL OF OR AMENDMENT TO GOODHUE COUNTY OFFICIAL MAP NO. 1

Whereas, the Goodhue County Board of Commissioners adopted "Goodhue County Official Map No. 1" at its May 18, 2004 meeting following a public hearing by the Planning Advisory Commission on April 19, 2004, and;

Whereas, Goodhue County Official Map No. 1 includes portions of federal/state, county, township, and city roads in Sections 27, 28, 29, 32, 33, 34, and 35 of Township 109 North Range 15 West, Goodhue County, Minnesota, and;

Whereas, the City of Pine Island has been approached by a developer interested in annexing and developing land encumbered by Official Map No. 1, and such developer has requested a release or repeal of Official Map No. 1 for purposes of such development, and;

Whereas, due to street and highway improvements completed since 2004, the City Council does not believe the right-of-way mapped on Official Map No. 1 is needed for future street and highway purposes.

Whereas, the City of Pine Island understands that the repeal or amendment of Official Map No. 1 will result in discontinuing plans for a future interchange at the north intersection of US 52 and Goodhue CSAH 11.

Whereas, the City of Pine Island understands that the repeal or amendment of Official Map No. 1 will result in MnDOT permanently closing the on movement of northbound CSAH 11 to southbound US 52 and that the off movement from southbound US 52 to CSAH 11 will remain open.

Whereas, the City of Pine Island understands that the repeal or amendment of Official Map No. 1 will result in the existing interchange at US 52 and Goodhue CSAH 11 remaining open as a full movement interchange.

Now, therefore be it resolved, that the City of Pine Island recommends that the Goodhue County Board of Commissioners repeal of Official Map No. 1 or amend such official map to reidentify right-of-way that continues to be needed for future street and highway purposes in Sections 27, 28, 29, 33, 34 and 35 of Township 109 North, Range 15 West, Goodhue County, Minnesota. Adopted by the City Council of the City of Pine Island this 21° day of 32025.
