Re: Sentencing to Service Program Implementation

On June 17, 2025, the County Board authorized the County Administrator to establish a Sentence to Service (STS) Program to be operated by Goodhue County, following a review of the options presented (see attached). This authorization included both the implementation of an interim plan to hire a temporary crew leader and the development of a long-term plan to be incorporated into the 2026 budget.

It has been determined that without the STS Coordinator position in the interim plan, operating a minimal crew would not be cost-effective. At this time, full crews are not anticipated due to the inability to schedule individuals sentenced from the street. Currently, only one or two individuals housed in the adult detention center are eligible to participate.

Staff is requesting approval to proceed with the long-term plan to ensure the STS program is fully operational before the end of 2025. Advancing the plan at this time would reduce reliance on contracted services during the fall and winter months and help minimize overtime costs incurred by County staff. Additionally, it would allow for minimal disruption to the program and ensure continued opportunities for individuals sentenced by the courts to participate.

Staffing Plan:

2.0 FTE Crew Leaders – Allows for seven-day-a-week coverage for both adults and juveniles 1.0 FTE STS Coordinator/Case Aide

Budget Impact:

All projected expenses are detailed in the attached document. If the program becomes operational by **November 1, 2025**, the total cost for the remainder of 2025 is estimated at approximately **\$86,876**. This cost would be fully offset by funds already allocated in the 2025 operating budget for the STS contract and salary savings from retired court services staff. Use of fund balance would only be required if we are unable to acquire the current state-owned STS vans.

Full implementation of this program is expected to increase the operating budget and impact the levy by approximately **\$137,000 annually** beginning in 2026.
