 Complete, pending end-user training and removal of old equipment
- Upgrade Network Connections to Public Works and Health & Human Services Building Complete, pending final backbone connection in main Data Center Recycling Center is not connected to County's private fiber network
- 3. Increase Wireless Network Coverage at Government Center Campus Installation of hardware replacements complete Installation of additional hardware pending cable installation
- Assist Recorder's Office with EDMS Upgrades
 In progress; hardware received; estimated completion August 2018
- 5. Renegotiate Microsoft Volume Licensing agreement In progress; current agreement ends 10/31/2018
- 6. Assist Auditor/Treasurer Office with Property Tax System Upgrades
 Software vendor is in process of testing functionality in new system; first counties will convert in Q3 or Q4 of 2018
