FACILITIES MAINTENANCE: Request for part-time, phased retirement position.

Tim Redepenning put forth a request to add a part-time, phased retirement position at 14 hours per week. This position would work on projects such as window and carpet cleaning as well as covering staff vacations.

PUBLIC WORKS: Request to create Engineering Trainee position.

Greg Isakson put for a request to create an Engineering Trainee position. Mr. Isakson summarized he difficulty the department has had in hiring and retaining an Engineering Technician. Mr. Isakson would like to explore creating a position whereby we would be able to train an employee internally to eventually become an Engineering Technician – with the hope of retaining the individual on a longer term basis.

Commissioner Majerus expressed concerns with this plan that we would train the individual and then be more marketable to neighboring counties or similar organizations.

Commissioner Anderson supports creating the trainee position. Commissioner Majerus said he needs more information in order to support the new classification.
