CIVIL RIGHTS PLAN

GOODHUE COUNTY HUMAN RESOURCES

PURPOSE

Ensures all eligible individuals receive equal access to programs, services and information. Its programs are operated in a nondiscriminatory way, which protects from discrimination based on but not limited to race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex, marital status, disability, sexual orientation, and status with regard to public assistance.

The Civil Rights Plan (CRP) serves as a source of information for county agency staff and the general public. It sets out Goodhue County's civil rights administrative policies and procedures, identifying key contacts within the county and linking the reader to state and federal civil rights laws and resources.



You have a right to file a civil rights complaint if you believe you have been discriminated against.

It is against the law for anyone who works for Goodhue County to retaliate against a person who files a complaint or who cooperates in the investigation of a civil rights complaint.

Civil rights complaints on age discrimination must be submitted to the Civil Rights Contact within 180 days of the date the alleged discrimination occurred, while all other civil rights complaints must be submitted to the Civil Rights Contact within 365 days of the date the alleged discrimination. occurred.

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)

Goodhue County has designated an ADA Contact to facilitate concerns on disability matters raised by applicants, clients, and members of the public. ADA Contact information is located on the cover of the Goodhue County Civil Rights Plan.

Following several hours of negotiations between law enforcement and the individual; law enforcement determined it appropriate to take the individual into custody despite clear surrender terms. After having received a signed warrant from a judge in Olmstead County, SWAT teams onsite deployed less lethal rounds. The individual returned fire and hit law enforcement vehicles but thankfully no one was hit with any return fire.

The individual involved in the incident ultimately surrendered and was taken into custody. This incident took place within the jurisdiction of Olmstead County and all charges will be given by the Olmstead County Attorney's Office. It should be noted Goodhue County Sheriff's Office contracts with the City of Pine Island and has been on scene for the duration of the incident. In addition to the aforementioned agencies involvement, an Emergency Response Team (ERT) from both Goodhue and Wabasha County, an Emergency Response Unit (ERU) from Olmstead and Rochester, City of Pine Island Public Works, and ambulances from Mayo Clinic were on scene as well.

Thank you to those who remained in shelter and avoided the area. The incident is cleared. The Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) will assist in the investigation.

[Red Wing, MN] - The Goodhue County Board of Commissioners will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, September 6, 2022 at 9:00 AM to consider prospective appointees to temporarily fill the District 5 vacancy on the County Board of Commissioners. This hearing will be held in the County Board Room, 509 West 5th Street, Red Wing, MN 55066.

Commissioners will hear public testimony from persons residing in District 5 of Goodhue County. Provided public testimony must be relating to the qualifications of prospective appointees to fill the current vacancy of the District 5 Commissioner seat. The prospective appointee will serve until a special election can be conducted.

Any qualified individual who would like to be considered for said appointment should submit in writing the following information: name, address, contact information, qualifications, and statement of interest to the address provided below. All prospective appointees must turn in the aforementioned information by August 31st, 2022 at 4:00 PM. Prospective appointees must meet all qualifications required to hold office, including the following: must be an eligible voter; is 21 years of age or more; and must be a resident of District 5.




