- 1. County ARPA Funded Broadband Grant Program

- 3. Completed Physical Inventory of all County IT Hardware
- 4. Implemented physical Election Security/Monitoring systems
- 5. Implemented Electronic Document Management System (EDMS) for Human Resources
- 6. County Email migrated to Microsoft Office365
- 7. Migration of HHS EDMS (OnBase) to new CaseWorks system
- 8. Implemented new Disk-to-Disk network Backup System
