

_____ TOWNSHIP FIREARMS ORDINANCE

The township board of _____, Goodhue County, Minnesota does ordain:

1. It shall be unlawful for any persons:

a. To possess or discharge upon the land of another, any firearm, said firearm to include rifle, shot gun, pistol or device capable of propelling metal pellets by air, spring, C.D. 2 or other means, without having on his or her person written permission from owner or person in occupancy of said land.

2. Any person who shall violate this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days or both, for such offense.

3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication according to law.
