Kenyon Park Rules

- 1. The park is open from 5:00 AM to 10:00 PM, no overnight camping allowed.
- 2. The park will be closed for the local MN deer firearm seasons. Please contact the Goodhue County Sheriff's Department at 651-385-3155 to retrieve game.
- 3. The following activities are **prohibited** in the park:
 - To operate or park any motor vehicle within the boundaries of the park except upon designated roads or parking areas.
 - To burn or otherwise dispose of garbage, refuse, or trash of any kind. This is a carry-in; carry-out park.
 - To hunt or disturb wildlife.
 - To display or to have in one's possession firearms or other dangerous weapons including explosives, air guns, slingshots, traps, seines, nets, bows and arrows.
 - To engage in any brawling or fighting, or to engage in offensive, obscene, abusive, boisterous or noisy conduct or to engage in offensive, obscene, or abusive language tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger or resentment in others.
 - To display or to have in one's possession glass bottle containers.
 - To use or have in one's possession alcoholic beverages in containers larger than two liters.
 - To be in possession of or under the influence of any drug which is in violation of federal or state law.
 - To operate any vehicle in a reckless manner or at a speed in excess of the posted speed limit. (15 mph)
 - To cut, damage, or remove trees, shrubs, plants, and other vegetation, with the exception of harvesting edible fruits and mushrooms for personal consumption. Commercial harvesting is not allowed. It is not allowed to pick wildflowers or other plants, even for personal use.
 - To deface, damage or remove any park property.
 - To dispose of cut grass, tree trimmings or personal property on the park grounds.
- 4. Pets are permitted in county parks. Such animal shall be attended and effectively controlled, shall not run at large, and shall not disturb wildlife. All droppings must be picked up and disposed of. Pets shall not deprive or disrupt the enjoyment or use of the park by others.
- 5. Horses are restricted to the roadways and designated parking areas. All droppings must be picked up and removed.
- 6. Fires are prohibited within the park.
- 7. Any person who violates the above rules will be asked to conform to those rules or immediately leave the park. Said person may be prosecuted to the full extent allowed by the law.
- 8. Any person who violates this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor, and subject to immediate removal from such park.
